Minimum System Requirements

 - [Microsoft®](#) Access 97 (minimum version)

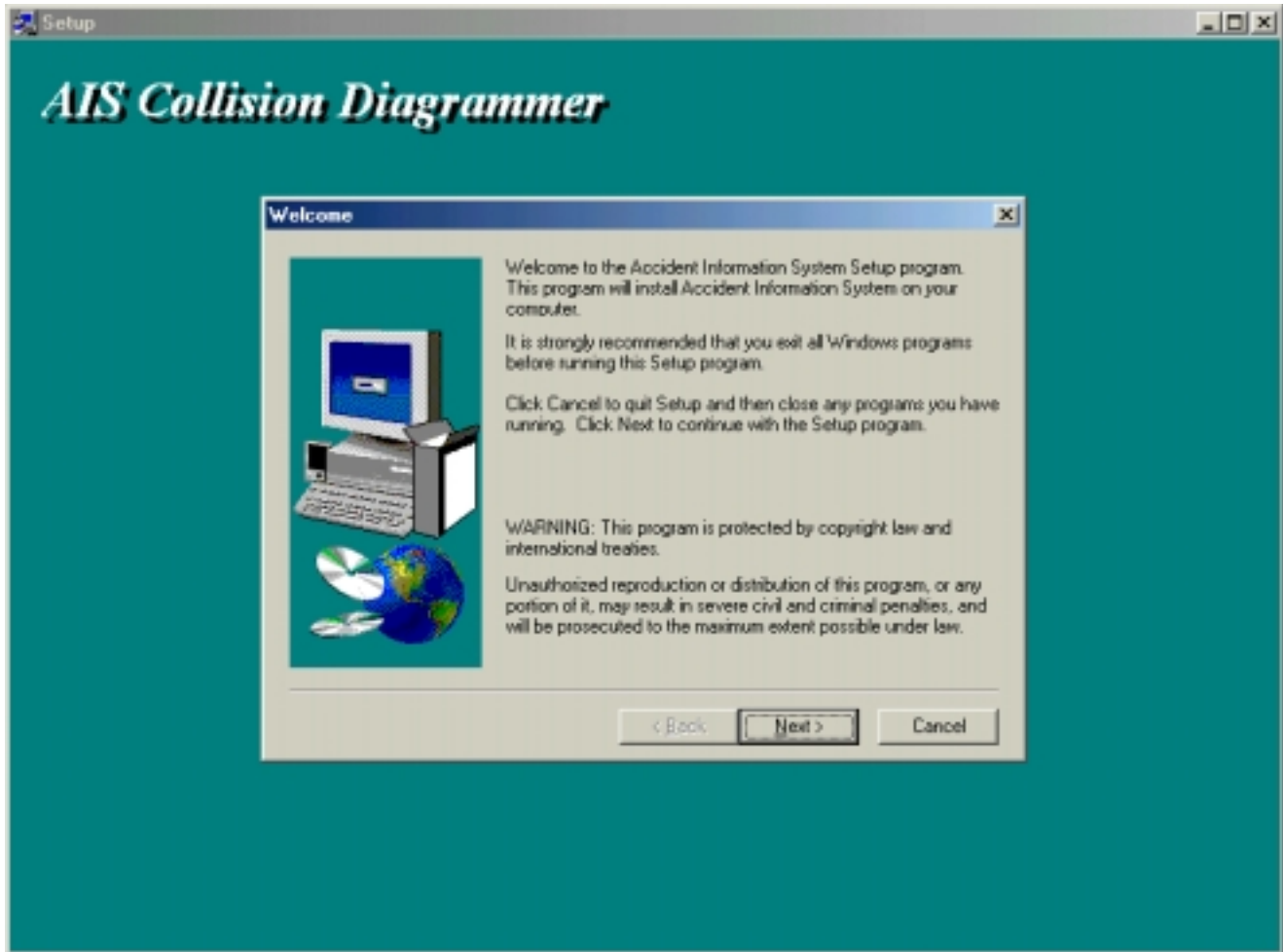
Installing AIS Collision Diagrammer (AIS CD)

The AIS Collision Diagrammer installs easily from a file downloaded from the Viridian web site (<http://www.ViridianTech.com>) or from a CD-ROM provided by Viridian Technologies, Inc.

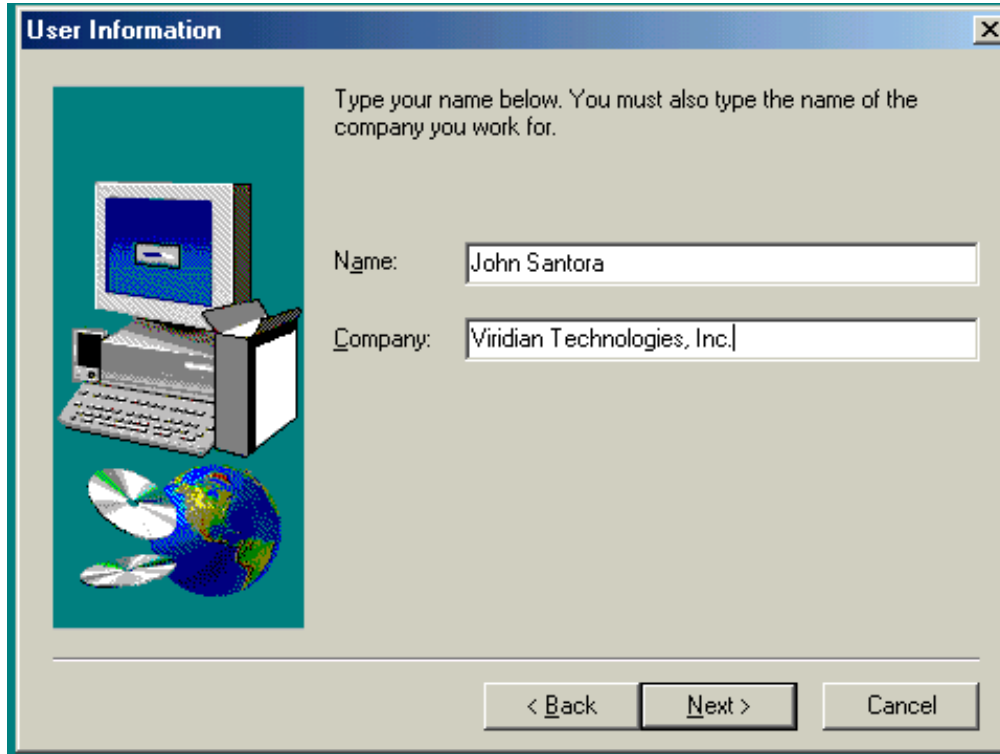
If you downloaded the AIS CD installation file from the website:

- Unzip the installation file to any temporary directory.
- Double-click on the Setup.exe file and follow the prompts.

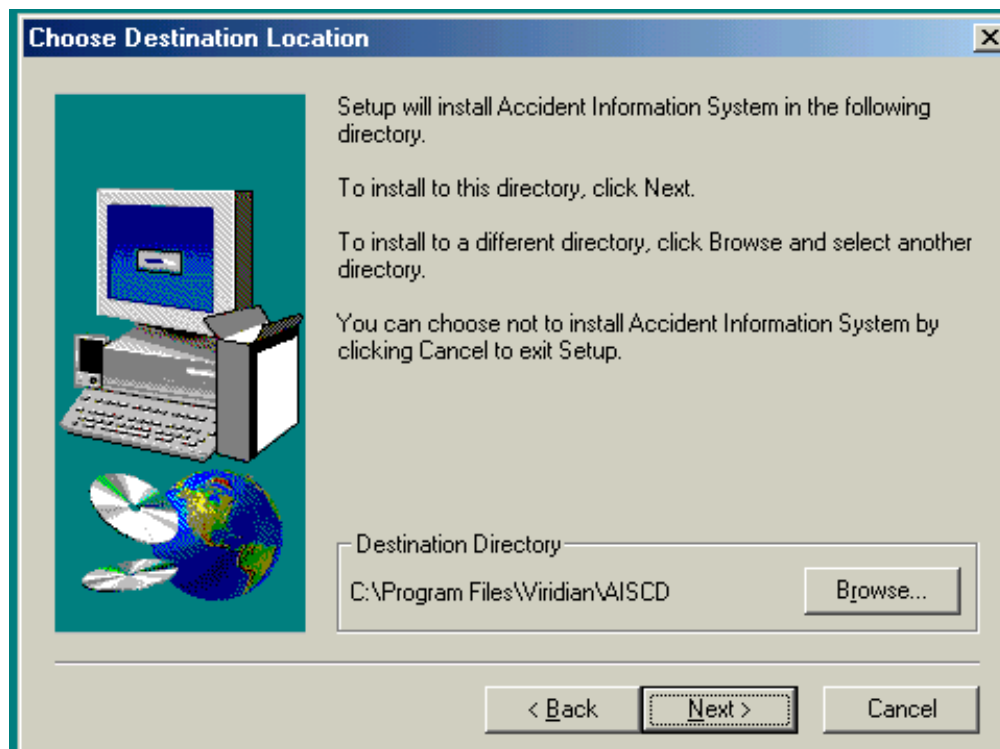
If you are installing AIS CD from a CD ROM, there will be an installation directory with the expanded installation files. Double-click on the Setup.exe file and follow the prompts.



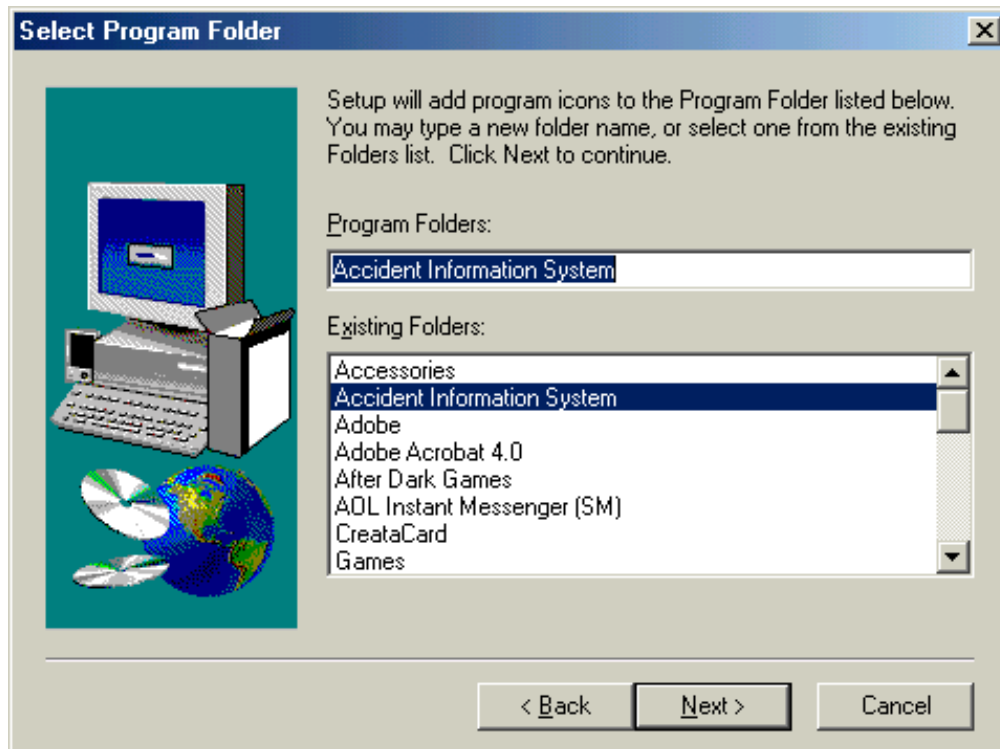
Fill in your Name and Company.



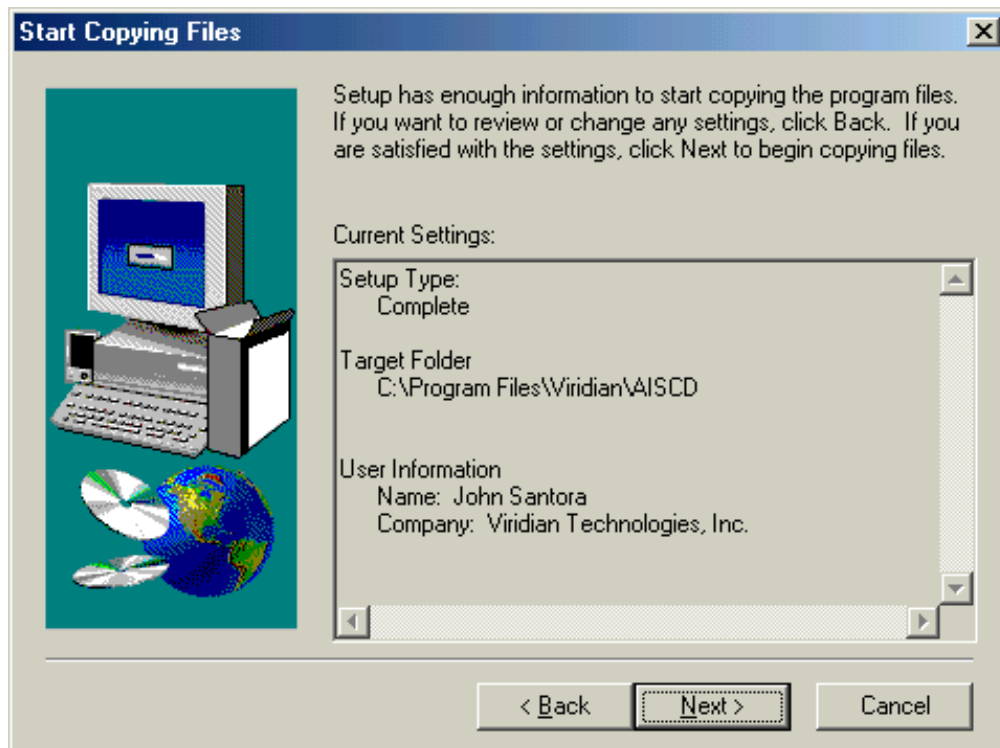
Next, you will be asked to select a directory for the installation of AIS CD. When installing the Demonstration version of the Collision Diagrammer, you must accept the default directory shown below. (The Production Version can be installed to any directory.) This will make it easier to apply updates to your system, as the update packages assume you have installed the application in C:\Program Files\Viridian\AISCD. (If you need to install the application in another directory, you will need to have some experience with WinZip in order to apply the update packages.)



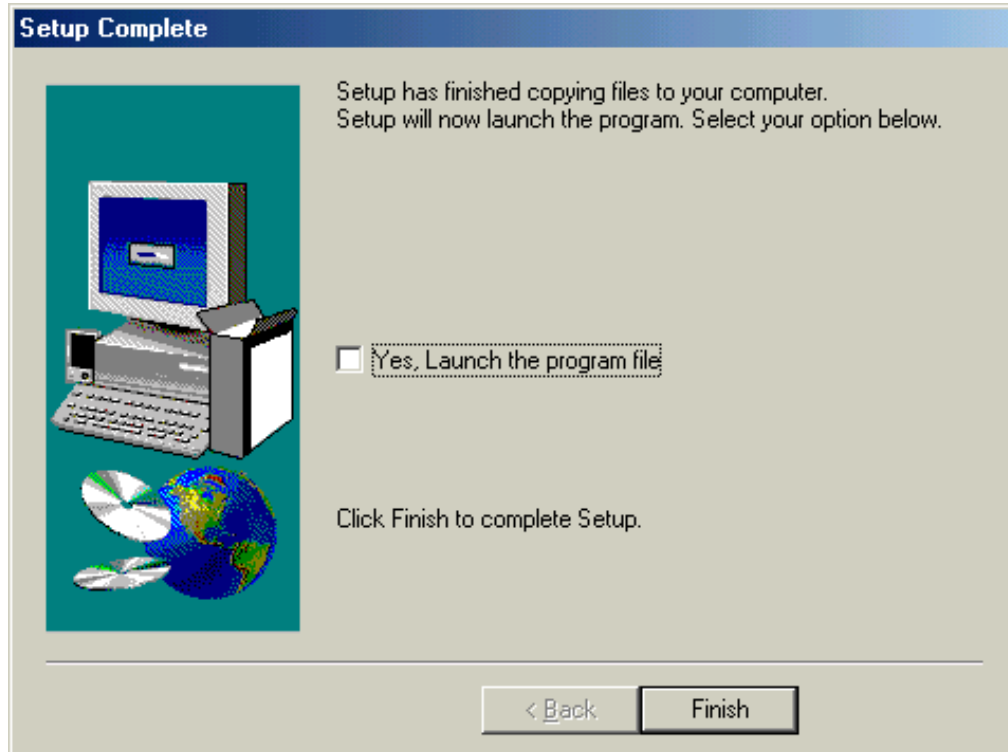
You can accept the default folder name for the application, type in a new name of your choosing or select an existing folder from the list. Choosing the default folder “Accident Information System” will place the program icon for AIS CD with the AIS primary system.



Use this screen to review your typing. Click the Back button if you wish to make changes.



This completes the Installation of AIS CD on your computer. You can either click **Finish** or directly Launch the AIS CD application at this time.



Starting and Logging onto the System

To start AIS CD from the Start Menu:

- Click the **Start** button
- Click **Programs**
- Click **Accident Information System**
- then click **AIS - Collision Diagrammer** from the side menu that appears.

This will open the AIS Collision Diagrammer. No User ID or Password is required to use AIS CD.
